- Deliver script as a PDF; screenplay should follow basic formatting parameters
- UMFF will help with raising additional funds; however keep in mind, the film will be made on a low budget (limit your locations, etc.)
- Finalized film must have its world premiere at the Urban Mediamakers Film Festival.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Strong storyline and characters
- Originality/creativity
- Clarity
- Budget restriction three locations maximum
